

French River, Ontario, Canada

Overview

The French River runs in Ontario, from Lake Nipissing, near North Bay, to the Georgian Bay of Lake Huron. This river, combined with the Mattawa via one of the worst portages known as La Vase, makes a route across two major watersheds, and has been used by the natives, the Jesuits, the coureur des bois, and the Voyageur. Nowadays, it is still paddled, for recreational purposes however.




















