


Schroon River (Adirondacks, New York, USA) - Starbuckville to Riverbank

Suggested Water Levels

At 3.6 ft, there was plenty of water. Because it is fed by Schroon lake, this river tends to have good levels for a longer period than other rivers of the area.

Difficulty

At a level of 3.6 ft, mostly flat water and class 2 rapids, with some class 2-3 rapids and one class 3 drop.

Driving directions

Delorme New York Atlas and Gazetteer page 88.

- Put-in at Starbuckville: Hwy 87, exit 25, go east for 0.3 km (0.2 mi), cross the bridge, turn left on Watering Tub Road, there is a small parking area a few meters from the bridge.
- Take-out at Riverbank: Hwy 87, exit 24, go east for 0.2 km (0.15 mi), cross the bridge and continue for the same distance past the bridge, turn left on Schroon River East Road. There is a Canoe Access Site at about 0.4 km (0.3 mi) on Schroon River East Road.

Shuttle: 11 km (7 mi) via Hwy 87.
