

Starting at site of old Twin Brook leanto, route heads generally ESE (about 120° compass heading). About .4 m from leanto a good gravel road is reached. Follow road left for about 20 yards to a gravel pit. Enter and cross pit, exiting at E end on a boggy lumber road. Route criss-crosses and occasionally follows old lumber roads, crossing Lower Twin Brook at about 1.6 m and reaches a height of land at about 2.4 m. The route then descends through thickets reaching beaver activity at 2.9 m. At about 3.1 m walk on L bank of outlet from beaver pond. A tributary of Skylight Brook is reached at 3.3 m; pitch up and over a divide to cross main stream of Skylight at about 3.5 m. Route climbs a few dozen yards out of brook ravine and meets old herd path. Heading L (East and up) it's another .6 m to meet Allen Brook below a small falls. Summit gained via Allen Brook. ("Guess-timated" distances by Chris Behr, 46er Trailmaster, who laid out route.)
